NWEA MAP Math RIT Scores

Below are the average MAP Math RIT Scores across grades 2-5 comparing math achievement between the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 school years. Facts on Fire implementation began in August of 2025 and was done through the entirety of the 2025-2026 school year. Substantial growth in terms of both level and trend (growth percentiles) was shown.

Graphs across each grade are provided with the 2024-2025 school year on top and the 2025-2026 school year on the bottom. Data are color coded with each color representing percentile cutoffs (red 0-20; orange 21-40, yellow 41-60, green 61-80, and blue 81-100).

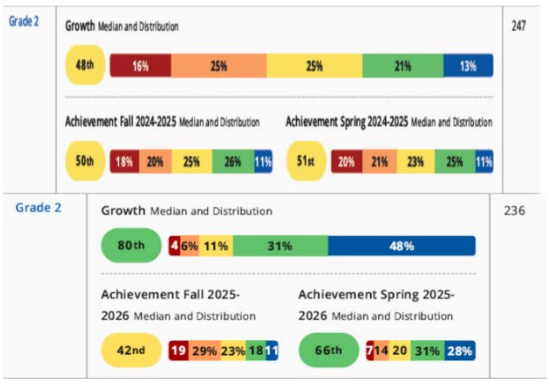
Growth level data showed aggressive increases across grades and the percentile breakdown was equally impressive with 48, 43, 51, and 52 percent of students showing high growth (81st percentile and above). Achievement level data also saw large shifts showing increases in the percentage of students scoring in the high and high average range (61st percentile and above and a decreasing amount of students scoring the low and low average range (40th percentile and below). These data converge to support a significant increase in math achievement with the introduction and implementation of the Facts on Fire program.

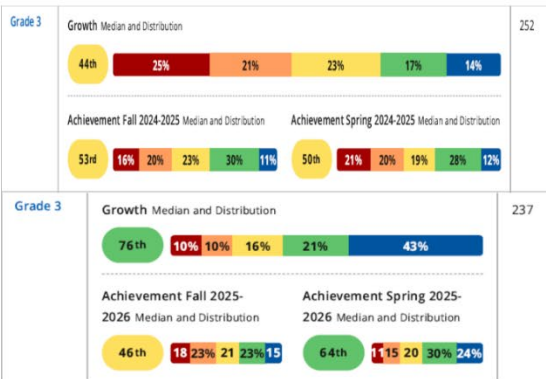

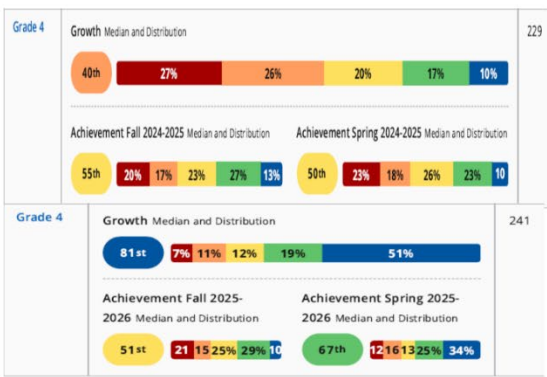

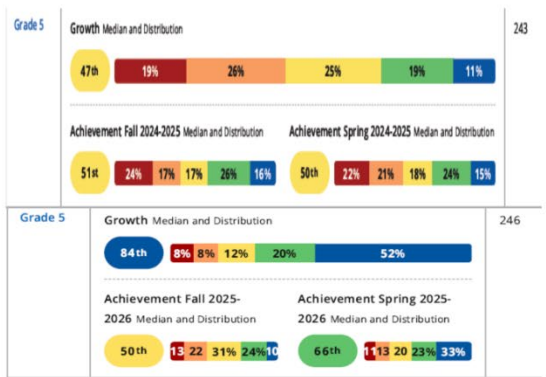
